Thank you for your prayers for our first full month back. We have been blessedly busy since the minute we landed. The opening of ABC Academy for the 2014 school year went well and routines are now in place. With 62 enrolled, it is keeping our teachers very busy. I have the joy of teaching our twelve oldest students for two hours a day. It amazes me that they entered the school not knowing a word of English a couple years ago and now they are receiving instruction entirely in English. I praise God for the work Emi and her teachers have done and are doing. I am also thankful for Miss Hannah, our missionary piano teacher, who is doing a great job with her 14 piano students and with teaching in the school.

March promises to be an intensely busy month with our Canadian mission team coming on March 17th for our building project and the estimated March 11th arrival of our cargo (Samoan Bibles, pianos, school books, radio station and sound system equipment, etc.) Getting that all cleared through customs over in the capital and delivered way out here is always a big ordeal, so please pray.
